The Sabres Football have had a terrific season. The success on the field is the result of excellent attendance and hard work in practice. The season includes exhibition game wins against Leduc and Olds.

The Sabres finished the regular season in fourth place with a 3 wins 3 losses record. Each of the losses were in close games where the team learned and grew, setting them up for success in the league playoffs.

In the semifinal playoff game on October 26 in Drayton Valley the Sabres won 26-16 over the first place team from Drayton Valley. In the league championship on November 4 the Sabres won 20-18 in Sylvan Lake.

The team advances to provincial playoffs at the Tier III level. Tier III schools have student populations between 400 and 749. Their game on November 11th is against Holy Rosary HS in Lloydminster.
