

Important Information

1. **Who?** Grade 9 science students.
2. **Where?** **Telus World of Science** in Edmonton.
3. **When?** **April 27th** – **buses leave at 9:00** and will return before 3:18.
4. **Why?** To enrich our students knowledge and interest in science, and to review topics already covered in class in preparation for their final exams.
5. **How much?** \$15.00 per student which includes transportation and admission fees. Should financial constraints be an issue, please contact the office at 352-2295.
6. **Supervisors?** Some of the staff from the school will be along to supervise this activity. However, as a large number of people will be taking part, a few extra parent volunteers are required to accompany this size of a group.

I. Before the Field Trip
