Biology 20 Field Study - X-Stream Science

The WCHS Science Department is excited to announce that this year for the Biology 20 field study students will be participating in the Battle River Watershed Alliance's (BRWA) X-Stream Science Program.

X-Stream Science is an inquiry- based learning opportunity lead by local experts to connect students to their watershed through real world science. Students will be travelling to Coal Lake where they will collect biological, chemical and physical data on the water and surrounding land. Water quality, quantity and land use data is collected, analyzed and stored to be monitored and compared over time. This data will help students and decision makers make good choices to help our watersheds.
