1.	Period of Agreement

3.	Termination		
	Notwithstanding anything herein contained to the contrary, any party, written hereto may, with or without cause, summarily terminate by giving written notice of termination to the parties to this agreement.		

4. Supervision

During the hours of employment herein set for the Student shall be under the direct supervision and control of the Employer; provided however, the Employer shall at all times permit the Board or its representatives access to the employment site and the Student.

5. Evaluation

The Employer shall at the request of the Board or its representatives, evaluate the student in the performance of his/her duties hereunder and report such evaluation on a form from time to time provided to the Employer by the Board.

6. Full-time Employee Tenure

The Employer agrees that the employment of the Student hereunder shall in no way affect the job security of any other employee of the Employer, nor the Employer's hiring practices with regard to full-time employees.

- 2. In the event that the Student is employed by the Employer outside the scope of this agreement, the Employer and Employee are subject to the *Alberta Labour Relations Code*, the regulations and orders thereunder.
