

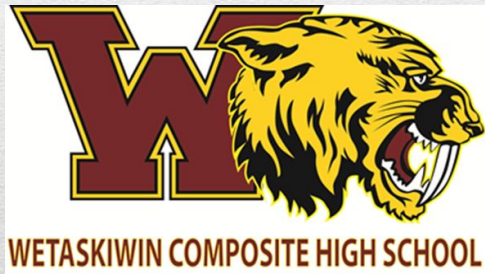

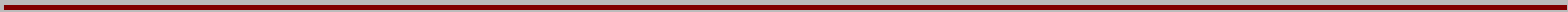

- Entrance requirements vary by program the best way to know is to check out the institution's website.
- Programs may have non-academic entrance requirements such as interviews, career investigation, police information checks, immunization requirements and computer literacy.

# Trades/Apprenticeships

1. Trade Entrance Requirements
  2. Secure a job placement under a Journeyperson for the trade you wish to acquire.
  3. Contact Alberta Apprenticeship and Industry Training to become a registered apprentice.
  4. They will confirm that you have met the academic requirements for the trade you wish to pursue.
  5. Start working to earn hours towards your apprenticeship.
  6. Complete Technical Training as your trade requires.
  7. Will be completed through locations such as NAIT, SAIT, Olds, Red Deer, Lakeland, Medicine Hat, Lethbridge and Portage Colleges.

# General Information

- Many schools now offer **first choice and second choice** options on applications so that you can apply to 2 different programs with one application and fee.
  - Most schools will offer:
    - Program Previews or Student for a Day
    - Open House
  - WCHS offers ELAA (Education Liaison Association of Alberta) each year. Come visit during that time and speak to a variety of recruiters from various post-secondary institutions.

# Application Dates

- Applications open **October 1** for the following year's Fall semester.
    - Eg: Apply in October 2022 for
  - Deadlines will vary based on institution and program but will generally fall between March and August - make sure you check for the programs you're interested in!
  - If you know the program you'd like to pursue - apply early!
  - Know whether the program you're interested in is **competitive, or first come, first serve** or a combination of both.

# Transition Year Program (TYP)- Must have English 30-1

In order to apply to the Transition Year Program, you must be:

- An Aboriginal applicant;
- 18 years and over;
- Have a minimum mark of 50% in each required subject; and,
- Have a minimum overall average of at least 60%.

You will also need between two and five high school subjects, depending on what degree you want to complete.

You **cannot** use the following courses: English 30-2, Social 30-2, Math 30-3, Science 24.

### You will need the following:

1. Your **Alberta Student Number (ASN)**. If you have applied to or attended a school or post-secondary institution in Alberta, you will already have an ASN. To find your ASN, you can use the [ASN Lookup](#) service. If you do not have an ASN, the ApplyAlberta system will assign one to you.
2. Names of **all high schools and post-secondary institutions you have attended or are currently attending**.
3. **High school courses and marks** (for currently enrolled students only).
4. A **credit card will be necessary** to pay any application fees charged by the institution(s).

## High School Courses and Marks

Current Canadian high school students are required to enter courses and marks.

Many institutions will use your course and mark information to determine eligibility to a program and to grant early admission before final marks are available.

If you are currently taking or plan to take courses prior to attending a post-secondary institution:

- Enter or select in-progress courses and courses you plan to complete.

For "Completed" courses enter the actual mark from a report card. For "In Progress" or "Planning to Take" courses you are entering an anticipated mark. Anticipated marks should be based on your current mark or the actual mark from a report card for the previous level course(e.g. BIOL 30 - in progress, use BIOL 20 - actual 80%). Grades can be percentage or letter system(e.g. 72 or B).

**Application-based scholarships** and awards are ones where you will need to fill out an application. Based on your background, experiences, academics, and interests there are many different scholarships available.

# Application Process

- Application processes may vary between scholarship programs.
- Once you have been accepted into a program you can apply through the University or College website.
- Many scholarship programs require supporting documentation such as a letter of recommendation, an essay or questions.
  - Description of life circumstances, short answer questions, educational goals and challenges,

Many scholarship applications require thoughtful reflection and should not be rushed.
