- The official grad list will be posted June 16, 2023. Students must be enrolled in any necessary courses and credits to fulfill minimum diploma/certificate requirements and have passing grades (50% +) in these courses/credits by June 16, 2023. Student Fee Accounts must be in good standing with the school.
- Class Photos will be taken prior to the Graduation Ceremony on June 27, 2023. Students are asked to meet in the WCHS Gym before 5:30 p.m. Envelopes for ordering a copy of the grad group photo will be available in the school office near the beginning of June. The cost for an 8x10 with a mount is \$15.00. Because the grad is at the end of June, NO LATE ORDERS can be accepted. Please have the envelopes returned to the photographer, with payment, before or immediately after the photo has been taken. Please make sure your name is clearly marked on the envelope.
- A complimentary photo of the grad shaking hands while receiving their diploma certificate will be taken at the ceremony. This photo will be given to the student at a later date provided all student fees are paid in full.

The 2022/23 Yearbook is expected to arrive early November.

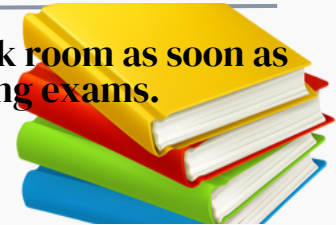


PE 30 Canoe trip
