#### Family School Liaison Corner: Understanding Self-Confidence and its Importance: Definition:

 Self-confidence is an attitude about your skills and abilities, involving acceptance and trust in oneself. It's linked to a positive outlook on life and can protect against mental health issues like depression and anxiety. Low self-esteem can make school life challenging and lead to low mood and anxiety.

#### Common Issues Affecting High School Students:

- Low Self-Esteem: A lack of confidence can negatively affect relationships, work, or studies and, without intervention, may also have a negative effect on mental and physical health.
- **Negative Self-Talk:** This refers to the internal dialogue characterized by self-criticism and doubt, which can have a profound impact on self-esteem and mental health.
- Fear of Failure: This is a common fear among teens, especially during the challenging time of high school, and can lead to a lack of self-confidence and shame.
- Academic Stress and Performance: High school can be a stressful time, with academic pressure and performance expectations potentially impacting mental well-being and self-esteem.
- **Body Image and Appearance:** Social pressures and comparisons can lead to negative body image and feelings about appearance, which can negatively impact self-esteem.
- **Bullying:** Bullying, whether physical, verbal, or online, can have long-lasting effects on a student's mental health, including anxiety, depression, and low self-esteem.
- **Social Anxiety:** The desire to be popular can lead to social anxiety, as individuals worry about how they are perceived by their peers, potentially leading to stress and emotional turmoil.


